Of course, all our impediments come from those “*called by His name*”; two initial problems, which we’re working on, first, funding, our organization is woefully underfunded, we only have a few people dependably funding all our efforts. On our part we hope to get our website ([try2help.charity](#)) to post grocery store receipts to show the donor that their donation goes to help buy food. Our second problem is we currently only have ONE dedicated scheduled volunteer (we’re serving food three day a week now) we also have only one couple they are consistent volunteers, who have really helped improved the quality of serves to our **Clients**. Bottom-line we need help/volunteers, hopefully we’ll get a calendar up on website so we can post who committed to which day and what they can provide.
